Contract for maintenance of garden in the Embassy of India premises

2. Scope of work will be as under :

- i. Supply of seasonable flowers.
- ii. Daily watering and maintenance of plants and grass.
- iii. Routine maintenance of sprinklers, drips and related irrigation system
- iv. Mowing of lawns as per requirement
- v. Removal of dead leaves and debris
- vi. Supply of fertilizers, pesticides, insecticides, etc as necessary
- vii. Pruning and trimming as necessary
- viii. Maintenance of indoor plants, cleaning of plants and planters
- ix. Provision of at least two gardeners daily for the required work of 8 hours
