- e-Tourist Visa (30 days, one year and 5 years)
- e-Business Visa (1 year multiple entry)
- e-Medical Visa (60 days), e-Medical Attendant Visa (60 days)
- e-Conference Visa (30 days Single Entry)
- e- AYUSH and AYUSH attendant (60 days)

- 5. Biometrics will be done at Indian port of arrival and no need to visit Indian Consular Application Centers for the same
- 6. E-visa processing would generally take 3-4 working days.

7. The following is the process for application of E-visa:

(I) Apply directly through the official Indian government portal: https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/evisa/

- (ii) To apply for an e-Visa, applicants must ensure the following:
 - A passport with at least 6 months validity and two blank pages
 - A recent passport-size photograph
- (iii) Additional documents based on visa category:
 - Business Visa: Invitation letter from an Indian company
 - Medical Visa: Letter from a recognized Indian hospital
 - Conference Visa: Invitation from event organizer, political clearance from Ministry of External Affairs, and event clearance from Ministry of Home Affairs

- (iv) Fees to be paid online using credit / debit card /payment wallet.
- (v). When visa is approved, an Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA) will be sent to the Email address provided by the applicant. Print ETA and after landing in India present it at Immigration Check Post where eVisa will be stamped on the Passport. Application and payment of fees should be done atleast 4 days prior to the date of travel.
- 8. E-Visa is valid for entry through designated 32 Airports and 5 seaports (the list can be checked here: https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/evisa/tvoa.html). However, the foreigner can take exit from any of the authorized Immigration Check Posts (ICPs) in India.
