

First World Solar Technology Summit (Virtual)

8th September, 2020 from 16.30 – 21.30 hrs (Indian Standard Time)

The International Solar Alliance Secretariat (ISA), India, is organizing virtually the First World Solar Technology Summit scheduled to be held on Tuesday, the 8th of September, 2020 from 16.30 – 21.30 hrs (Indian Standard Time). The Summit will begin at 16.30 hrs. (IST) with the Plenary Session to be addressed by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi.

The Summit's objectives are to bring together, key stakeholders and innovators from the governmental and private sectors to discuss recent developments in the field of solar energy and to showcase the state-of-the-art solar technologies that can help countries leapfrog to a decarbonized grid, at a reasonable and affordable cost. Several senior government functionaries and heads of global corporations, financial and multilateral institutions, think tanks, civil society and foundations are expected to be present during the inaugural session. There will also be a CEO conclave where CEOs of top global corporations that have made path-breaking progress in implementing and scaling up solar technologies will take part.
