Advisory for Indian nationals residing in Kuwait

- **Indian nationals presently residing in Kuwait on Work/Employment/Dependent/Family Visa should renew their Residency (Iqama) before its expiry. If not, Penalty Fee of KWD 2/- per day is charged by Kuwait Government authorities.**
- **You might also face Deportation/Re-entry ban, if the stay is not regularised.**
- **As per Kuwait Government laws, a minimum 'One Year Plus' validity on your Passport, on the date of renewal, is mandatory for affixing/renewal of Residency (Iqama).**
- **Passports may be renewed up to 18 months before its expiry, without assigning any special reason, from Indian Consular Application Centres (BLS). Passport Renewal applications shall be accepted even before this period of 18 months, for valid reasons.**
