

Scope of Work for Maintenance of garden at Embassy of India premises

➤ **Maintenance of both indoor and outdoor plants:**

1. Provision of 2 Nos regular gardeners to execute routine landscape maintenance operations and an option to increase if required and a landscape supervisor will monitor such works on daily basis. These personnel should be duly approved by the Public Authority for Agriculture and Fish Resources (PAAFR) to execute such maintenance works. The landscape supervisor should be available on a 24 hour-on call basis.
2. Fertilizers should be provided throughout the year as required (minimum 2 times) to ensure vigor and health to plants.
3. Pesticide and Fungicide application should be done as required periodically.
4. Maintenance of all existing plants in Embassy premises.

➤ **Supply of Plants:**

1. Supply and planting of good quality seasonal flowers (winter and summer seasons) with 3000 Nos in each season (Salvia, Dianthus, Petunia, Vinca, Portulaca and Marigold etc.).
2. Supply of good quality plants with pots (of the choice of Embassy) amounting to KD 3000/- to Embassy on an annual basis in addition to plants mentioned above
(Bidders should submit two quotes: (i) One quote with plants & pots.
(ii) One quote without plants & pots).

➤ **Maintenance of Sprinkler system:**

1. Provision of sprinkler Technician that will monitor and check the sprinkler system once a week and these personnel should be duly approved by the Public Authority for Agriculture and Fish Resources (PAAFR).
2. Routine maintenance operations such as cleaning/flushing of the drip system, Emitters and sprayers.
